Summary Report Submitted by Jim Merhaut of Coaching to Connect


In the Fall of 2017, Fr. Fedor commissioned a St. Joseph Planning Team including Parish Council and additional parishioners to study the ministries at St. Joseph Parish as well as explore the parish's relationship with the Austintown community. The Planning Team released a survey in the Spring of 2018 to gather parishioners' opinions about five key areas of church life: 1) Caring, 2) Learning, 3) Serving, 4) Worshipping, 5) Perspectives about Austintown. The survey response was very strong and provides valuable information about each area of church life.

The Planning Team has begun to make recommendations for ministries based on survey results. Additional research will be conducted in the near future on two areas of worship: music and family accommodations. Both were raised as concerns in the survey, but the details of the concerns were unclear. Focus groups on each topic will help the Planning Team understand what parishioners are saying on these topics.

The next phase of planning will include listening to leaders throughout the Austintown community. Planning Team members and other parishioners will learn about the strengths, trends, and challenges throughout Austintown Township. When this phase is completed, the team will discern goals and action steps to help shape the future direction of St. Joseph Parish and its mission in Austintown.












